# **FireFly Baton Instruction Manual**

Congratulations on your purchase of the Radiance LED Baton from FireFly Batons LLC! This baton is the product of years of prototyping and testing. We know you will enjoy it!

#### **How to Use the Radiance Baton**

- Download the "LED Hue" app for your smartphone or tablet.
- The app is available for Apple and Android devices.
- Open the app and turn on your baton.
- To connect your baton, swipe down anywhere in the upper box.
- You will see the name of your baton and the length Ex. "Radiance28" (Or "SP110") You can rename your batons in the app by pressing down on the name for a few seconds.
- Click on the baton name and the app will connect to the baton.
- Once connected, click on the "Enter" button at the bottom of the screen and a new screen will open.
- On this new screen you can select from a wide range of colors or programs to display on your baton
- The bottom of the page has sliders where you can adjust the brightness and the speed of the different programs.
- Please read the instructions for the app on the app store.
- The Bluetooth app can control one baton at a time. If you have multiple batons connect one baton, set the color or program and then connect another baton to set its color or program.

#### **How to Charge the Radiance Baton**

- On the color red at full brightness the battery will last about 50 minutes before requiring a charge. The color
  white and running programs will drain the battery faster. If the LED's get stuck on one color, get dim or stop
  changing, your baton needs to be charged. Turn the baton switch to the "Off" position and follow the
  instructions below.
- Ensure that the switch is in the "Off" position.
- Plug the USB charger that came with the baton into a USB port or charger. A tablet charger or computer USB port is recommended for charging your baton. You can even use a battery bank.
- Plug in your baton taking care to match up the 2 slots on top of the charging connector with the 2 raised guides on one side of the battery connection in the baton cap.

#### Important!

- Make sure the baton switch is in the "Off" position when not in use. Doing so will prevent unnecessary battery drain.
- Although the batons can survive drops on hard surfaces, it is recommended to twirl over grass or soft surfaces to prolong the life of the baton.
- Do not leave the baton in a hot car.

## Tightening screws



Over a long period of time with repeated hard drops, the screws may back out. To fix this use the following steps:

- Back the screw out using the allen wrench included with the baton.
- Press down around the screw hole and put the screw back in.




# Charging port



\*Note the slots on the charging cable and the prongs on the charging port. Take care to align cable with the prongs on the charging port. Do not force the connection
